This bill increases the license fee for gaming organizations from \$150 to \$200 for each city or county jurisdiction. The additional \$50 per license (\$68,000 total) based on 1,360 licenses held would be deposited in the Office of Attorney General's operating fund. Special funds currently used to fund essential services to gaming organizations will be depleted in the 2003-05 biennium, requiring additional funding.

The bill would not change the current general fund revenues included in the Governor's budget but would increase the Office of Attorney General's operating fund by \$68,000 (based on 1,360 licenses) to maintain essential services to gaming organizations including training provided to the organizations and toll-free assistance. This fee has not been changed since 1989.
