This bill extends the moratorium on RTC beds. As amended this bill also requires the department to explore the option of kinship care when a child is unable to return home and permanency options that are in the least restrictive care and near the childs home as required by the Adoption and Safe Family Act of 1997. This bill would also require the department of Human Services to issue a request for proposal for the provision of treatment services to meet the needs of youth with a history of sexual offenses that are currently being served by out of state facilities. The intent of the request for proposal is to enable North Dakota to provide the needed services in state. There is no fiscal impact since the Department is already incurring costs to treat these individuals.
