The Industrial Commission has adopted a policy of paying all its advisory board and council members the same compensation that legislators receive for attendance at interim committee meetings. This legislation would allow the Industrial Commission to pay compensation to four citizen members of the Lignite Research Council (two citizen members and two legislators) and citizen members of the Oil and Gas Research Council (up to seven). These two Councils receive their funding from special funds.

The Oil and Gas Research Council meets twice a year. If the seven citizen members are in attendance the cost would be \$700 per meeting for compensation.

The Lignite Research Council funding comes from the Lignite Research Fund. The appropriation for the Lignite Research Program is included in the Industrial Commission budget grants line item. The Oil and Gas Research Council funding comes from the Oil and Gas Research Fund which has a continuing appropriation and is not reflected in the

appropriations bill.
