## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 2-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

## Airport economic development fund.

- The airport economic development fund is a special fund in the state treasury.
  Subject to legislative appropriation, the aeronautics commission may provide grants from the fund to a public airport owned or operated by a public entity or to an airport operated by an airport authority in this state for the purpose of providing financial assistance for:
  - a. Purchase, development, and operation of automated weather reporting facilities, computers and terminals to obtain weather information relating to flight plans, and other equipment to enhance flight operational safety.
  - <u>b.</u> Obstruction removal within the runway protection zone of an airport to
     <u>facilitate the new global positioning satellite all-weather instrument approach</u>
     <u>technology required to meet federal standards.</u>
  - c. Construction or rehabilitation of runways, taxiways, and apron areas, including the extension of runways that do not meet the federal guidelines for this construction or rehabilitation but have a demonstrated state or local need.
  - <u>d.</u> <u>Development of airport infrastructure and buildings that do not meet federal</u> guidelines for this development but have a demonstrated state or local need.

1	<u>2.</u>	To qualify for a grant under this section, the airport must provide matching funds of
2		not less than ten percent and not more than fifty percent. The aeronautics
3		commission shall set the match requirement in accordance with guidelines
4		established by the commission by rule.
5	SEC	CTION 2. TRANSFER. During the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending
6	June 30, 20	09, the director of the office of management and budget shall transfer \$5,000,000
7	from the ge	neral fund to the airport economic development fund.
8	SEC	CTION 3. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
9	airport ecor	nomic development fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of
10	\$5,000,000	, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the aeronautics commission for the
11	purpose of	this Act, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009.
