BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA: 4

5 SECTION 1. A new subsection to section 57-39.2-04 of the North Dakota Century Code 6 is created and enacted as follows: 7 Gross receipts from sales of nonprescription drugs and health products for human 8 use or consumption, prepackaged for use by consumers, and labeled in accordance with the requirements of state and federal law. For purposes of this 9 10 section, "nonprescription drugs and health products" means: 11 Allergy relief products, asthma medications, and sinus medications. a. 12 Cold medications, cough drops and lozenges, cough syrups, nasal b. 13 decongestants, sore throat remedies, and topical vapor products. 14 Antacids and antigas products, antidiarrheal preparations, antinausea C. 15 preparations, and laxatives. 16 Feminine deodorants and itching remedies, feminine yeast infection remedies. d. 17 and feminine personal lubricants. 18 Arthritis pain relievers, general pain relievers, and menstrual relief products. e. 19 f. Herbal products, vitamins, and minerals sold as nutritional supplements. 20 g. Acne aids; anti-itch products; corn, callus, and wart removers; diaper rash 21 products; eye care products; first-aid products; fungicidal preparations; hair 22 regrowth treatments; hemorrhoidal preparations; oral care products; and 23 topical analgesics. 24 Home diagnostic test kits, sleeping aids, and smoking cessation aids.
