## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 5-01-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

5-01-08. Persons under twenty-one years of age prohibited from manufacturing, purchasing, consuming, or possessing using alcoholic beverages or entering licensed premises - Penalty - Exceptions - Referrals to addiction facilities - Jurisdiction.

- 1. Except as permitted in this section and section 5-02-06, a person under twenty-one years of age may not manufacture or attempt to manufacture, purchase or attempt to purchase, consume or have recently consumed other than during a religious service, be under the influence of, be in possession of, or furnish money to any person for the purchase of an alcoholic beverage, or.
- 2. A person under twenty-one years of age may not enter any licensed premises where alcoholic beverages are being sold or displayed, except a:
  - <u>a.</u> A restaurant when if accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, or in;
  - b. In accordance with section 5-02-06, or if;
  - <u>c.</u> <u>If</u> the person is a law enforcement officer or other public official who enters the premises in the performance of official duty; or if
  - d. If the person enters the premises for training, education, or research purposes under the supervision of a person twenty-one or more years of age with prior notification of the local licensing authority.
- 3. A violation of this section is a class B misdemeanor.

- <u>A</u> person under twenty-one years of age may remain in an area of a site where beer, wine, or sparkling wine is sold in accordance with the conditions of an event permit issued pursuant to section 5-02-01.1. Any
  - 4. A person who is nineteen years of age or older but under twenty-one years of age may be employed by the restaurant to serve and collect money for alcoholic beverages, if the person is under the direct supervision of a person twenty-one or more years of age, but may not be engaged in mixing, dispensing, or consuming alcoholic beverages. Any establishment where alcoholic beverages are sold may employ persons from eighteen to twenty-one years of age to work in the capacity of musicians under the direct supervision of a person twenty-one or more years of age.
  - For purposes of this section, a person is not twenty-one years of age until eight a.m. on that person's twenty-first birthday.
- **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
