5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-12.1-17 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:

- 7 43-12.1-17. Nursing education programs.
- 8 The state board of higher education shall adopt rules establishing establish 1. 9 standards for in-state nursing education programs leading to initial or advanced 10 licensure. In establishing these standards, the state board of higher education 11 shall consider whether the program is accredited by the national league for nursing 12 accrediting commission, incorporated, or its successor; the commission on 13 collegiate nursing education or its successor; or other nationally recognized 14 accreditation organization. A nursing education program may not be provided in 15 this state unless the state board of higher education has approved the program. 16 The state board of higher education shall approve, review, and reapprove nursing 17 education programs in this state. The state board of higher education may not require a statement of intent as part of the approval process under this section. 18 19 The standards established under this section for a program leading to licensure as 2. 20 a licensed practical nurse: 21 Must allow for a program that offers two or more academic years of course a. 22 study or the equivalent; 23 b.
