- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 55-10-12 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the historical marker program.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 55-10-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 55-10-12. Authority to mark sites State historical marker program. The director of
- 7 the state historical society may authorize, fund, and place state historical markers on any site
- 8 listed in the state historic sites registry. This includes authority to negotiate with private
- 9 property owners to mark privately owned sites but does not include agreements to pay private
- 10 property owners compensation to mark the property develop and administer a historical marker
- 11 program for the purpose of identifying local, state, and national points of interest in this state.
- 12 The society shall authorize official markers to mark recognized sites and shall maintain an
- 13 official historical markers' sites listing. All costs, including production, installation, and
- 14 <u>maintenance of a historical marker are the responsibility of the applicant or sponsor of the</u>
- 15 marker.
