- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 12.1-17-01 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to simple assault.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 12.1-17-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 amended and reenacted as follows:

12.1-17-01. Simple assault.

- 1. A person is guilty of an offense if that person:
- 8 a. Willfully causes bodily injury to another human being; or
- 9 b. Negligently causes bodily injury to another human being by means of a
 10 firearm, destructive device, or other weapon, the use of which against a
 11 human being is likely to cause death or serious bodily injury.
- 12 2. The offense is:
- 13a.A class C felony when the victim is a peace officer or correctional institution14employee acting in an official capacity, which the actor knows to be a fact, a15person engaged in a judicial proceeding, or a member of a municipal or16volunteer fire department or emergency medical services personnel unit or17emergency department worker in the performance of the member's duties.
- 18b.A class B misdemeanor for the first offense when the victim is an actor's19family or household member as defined in subsection 4 of section 14-07.1-0120and a class A misdemeanor for a second or subsequent offense when the21victim is an actor's family or household member as defined in subsection 4 of22section 14-07.1-01 and the actor has a prior conviction for simple assault23under this section or an assault offense under section 12.1-17-01.1 or
- 24 <u>12.1-17-02</u> involving the commission of domestic violence as defined in

1		subsection 2 of section 14-07.1-01. For purposes of this subdivision, a prior
2		conviction includes a conviction of simple any assault offense in which a
3		finding of domestic violence was made under a law or ordinance of another
4		state which is equivalent to this subdivision.
5	C.	A class B misdemeanor except as provided in subdivision a or b.
