FIRST ENGROSSMENT with House Amendments

- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 20.1-03-12 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to license fees for nonresident wholesale bait vendor licenses;
- 3 to amend and reenact subsections 25 and 45 of section 20.1-03-12 and section 20.1-06-14 of
- 4 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the regulation and licensing of wholesale bait
- 5 vendors; to provide for transition; and to declare an emergency.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsections 25 and 45 of section 20.1-03-12 of the North
 Dakota Century Code are amended and reenacted as follows:

- 9 25. For an annual resident license to sell minnows or other live bait at wholesale, thirty
 10 <u>fifty</u> dollars.
- 45. For an annual <u>class B</u> nonresident license to sell minnows or other live bait at
 wholesale, two hundred fifty dollars.
- 13 SECTION 2. A new subsection to section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota Century
- 14 Code is created and enacted as follows:
- For an annual class A nonresident license to sell minnows or other live bait at
 wholesale, five hundred dollars.

SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 20.1-06-14 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

20.1-06-14. Minnow bait wholesalers and retailers - License. The director shall
adopt rules to control and supervise the operations of minnow or other live bait wholesalers.
The director shall issue a license to each wholesaler when the wholesaler has complied with
the director's rules and has paid the appropriate annual license fee. The director shall also
shall issue a minnow or other live bait retailer's license to any person upon payment of the
appropriate license fee. No <u>A</u> person may <u>not</u> sell minnows or other live bait at wholesale or

1 retail without first obtaining the appropriate license. The director may require each retailer or

2 wholesaler to submit reports as the director may deem determine necessary. Licenses for

3 wholesalers issued under this section authorize the following:

4	<u>1.</u>	The annual resident license to sell minnows or other live bait at wholesale entitles	
5		the licensee to ten tags to mark bait-trapping equipment. A tag must be affixed to	
6		each trap used by the licensee. Upon request, the director shall issue additional	
7		tags to a licensee at a cost of five dollars per tag. A licensee may not import or	
8		export bait without first obtaining a permit from the director.	
9	<u>2.</u>	The annual class B nonresident license to sell minnows or other live bait at	
10		wholesale entitles a nonresident to import or export bait. A nonresident holding an	
11		annual class B nonresident license to sell minnows or other live bait at wholesale	
12		may not trap bait.	
13	<u>3.</u>	The annual class A nonresident license to sell minnows or other live bait at	
14		wholesale entitles the licensee to ten tags to mark bait-trapping equipment. A tag	
15		must be affixed to each trap used by the licensee. Upon request, the director shall	
16		issue additional tags to a licensee at a cost of five dollars per tag. The annual	
17		class A nonresident license to sell minnows or other live bait at wholesale entitles	
18		the licensee to trap in state waters with the permission of the director and permits	
19		the import and export of approved bait with the permission of the director. A	
20		nonresident may hold a class A license under this section if the nonresident's state	
21		of residence provides the same privilege for residents of North Dakota.	
22	22 SECTION 4. TRANSITION. The department may issue a license under this Act for the		
23	23 remainder of 2005 at a prorated fee.		
24	24 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
