- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to school reporting of student progress and achievement.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 State assessments Report to parents. Upon the release of state assessment
- 7 results by the superintendent of public instruction, each school shall issue a report to the
- 8 parents of each student. The superintendent of public instruction shall format the report to
- 9 contain the student's individual test scores based on the state standards. The information must
- 10 be presented in a fashion that allows the student's parent to easily compare the student's
- 11 progress and achievement to that of others:
- 1. In the student's classroom;
- 13 2. At the same grade level in the student's school and school district;
- 14 3. At the same grade level in contiguous school districts;
- 15 4. At the same grade level in the state; and
- 5. At the same grade level of the most current national assessment of educationprogress.
