BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. Civil action against state - Attorney's fees. The attorney's fees awarded to a plaintiff's attorney in a civil action against the state may not be calculated on a percentage fee basis. In a civil action against the state in which the plaintiff prevails, the court shall award attorney's fees based upon the number of hours reasonably expended on the litigation multiplied by a reasonable hourly rate. To determine the amount of attorney's fees to be awarded, the court shall consider the number of hours expended on the litigation, the 10 amount and nature of the judgment, the experience of the attorney, the fees customarily charged in the locality for similar legal services, the complexity of the litigation, the specialized 12 nature of the issues in the case, the urgency of the case, and the impact the payment of the 13 fees will have on the state.
