1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15-20.4-04 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to medical transcription schools; and to provide an expiration date.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15-20.4-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

6 15-20.4-04. Minimum standards - Exceptions. All postsecondary educational 7 institutions must be accredited by national or regional accrediting agencies recognized by the 8 United States department of education. The board may additionally require such further 9 evidence and make such further investigation as in its judgment may be necessary. Any 10 postsecondary educational institution operating in this state seeking its first authorization to 11 operate may be issued a provisional authorization to operate on an annual basis until the 12 institution becomes eligible for accreditation by a recognized accrediting agency. Upon 13 completion of the accreditation process, the institution shall submit evidence of accreditation, or 14 a substantial good-faith showing of progress toward such status. Only upon accreditation shall 15 an institution become eligible for a regular authorization to operate. This section does not apply 16 to postsecondary: 17 1. Postsecondary educational institutions operating in this state and enrolling ten 18 or fewer students; and

2. <u>Medical transcription schools</u>.

20 SECTION 2. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act is effective through June 30, 2007, and 21 after that date is ineffective.
