- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-04-14 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the registration renewal date for certain vehicles.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-04-14 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 amended and reenacted as follows:

39-04-14. Renewal of registration. Every vehicle registration, except those described in section 39-04-14.1, under this chapter expires on December March thirty-first each year and must be renewed annually upon application by the owner and by payment of the fees required by law, such. The renewal to take takes effect on the first day of January April each year. An owner who has made proper application for renewal of registration of a vehicle previous to January April first but who has not received the number plates, plate, or registration card for the ensuing year is entitled to operate or permit the operation of such the vehicle upon the highways upon displaying thereon on the vehicle the number plates or plate issued for the preceding year for such a period of time, to be prescribed determined by the department, as may be required to allow for the issuance of the new plates. If a previously registered motor vehicle whose gross weight exceeds ten thousand pounds [4535.92 kilograms] is purchased during the period the vehicle's registration in this state is expired, the registration fee must be

prorated on a monthly basis from the date of purchase to January April first.
