- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for an unemployment compensation shared work demonstration
- 2 project; to provide for a legislative council study; and to provide an appropriation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4	SECTION 1. JOB SERVICE NORTH DAKOTA - SHARED WORK DEMONSTRATION
5	PROJECT. During the 2005-06 interim, job service North Dakota shall develop, implement,
6	and operate a shared work demonstration project to demonstrate the feasibility of providing for
7	a statewide shared work unemployment compensation program. Job service North Dakota
8	shall seek the advice of the unemployment insurance advisory council in developing,
9	implementing, and operating this demonstration project. The demonstration project must:

- 1. Operate for no more than five selected employers, each of which must have at least seventy-five employees and must be experienced-rated employers.
- Operate in accordance with a specific written agreement between job service North Dakota, the selected employers, and the labor representative of the collective bargaining agreement if a collective bargaining agreement exists.
- Allow shared work compensation to be paid to employees who, being otherwise
 eligible for unemployment insurance benefits, have their working hours reduced by
 the selected employer by at least ten percent but no more than sixty percent.
- 4. Operate in such a manner that the selected employers' unemployment insurance experience ratings are not compromised.
- Operate in such a manner that the unemployment trust fund is not so negatively impacted as to result in a greater tax burden to the remainder of the employers contributing to the trust fund.
- 6. Operate from January 1, 2006, through June 30, 2007, after which the demonstration project must cease.

1	7.	Provide that employees receiving benefits calculated solely under the shared work
2		demonstration project are not subject to the sixty percent weekly earnings
3		disregard provided for under section 52-06-06.
4	SEC	CTION 2. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY - SHARED WORK DEMONSTRATION
5	PROJECT.	During the 2005-06 interim, the Legislative Council shall consider studying the
6	implementa	tion of the shared work demonstration project established under section 1 of this
7	Act. If the I	egislative council conducts this study, the legislative council shall report its findings
8	and recomm	nendations, together with any legislation required to implement the
9	recommend	dations, to the sixtieth legislative assembly.
10	SEC	CTION 3. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
11	general fun	d in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$40,000, or so much
12	of the sum	as may be necessary, to job service North Dakota for the purpose of defraying any
13	implementa	tion costs associated with implementing the shared work demonstration project
14	under section	on 1 of this Act, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2007.
