- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 39-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to nonprofit organization number plates.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 39-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

### Nonprofit organization number plates - Definition.

- 1. As used in this section, "nonprofit organization" means a person that is recognized by the internal revenue service as tax exempt under 26 U.S.C. 501(c)(3) and which does not have as that person's primary focus sectarian activities, including activities aimed at promoting the adoption of one or more religious or political viewpoints.
- 2. Upon the request of a nonprofit organization in this state and compliance with this section, the director, in cooperation with that nonprofit organization, shall design distinctive number plates displaying the name, phrase, or graphic of that nonprofit organization. The director may not issue a nonprofit organization number plate for a nonprofit organization unless the nonprofit organization has collected and submitted to the director applications and the one-time fee for at least four hundred sets of plates.
- 3. The director may issue nonprofit organization number plates to the owner of a passenger motor vehicle or truck the gross weight of which does not exceed ten thousand pounds [4535.92 kilograms]. The director may issue the plates upon receiving payment of a one-time fee of ten dollars, payment of all other fees required under this chapter for the registration of a motor vehicle, and payment of a surcharge as determined by the nonprofit organization to be paid to the nonprofit

- organization corresponding to the number plate. The department shall collect the fees and the surcharge under this section. The department shall pay monthly the surcharges collected to the nonprofit organization for which a number plate was issued.
- 4. The director may adopt rules for the approval of the display of the name, phrase, or graphic.
- 5. To qualify for a nonprofit organization number plate, a nonprofit organization must apply in a form prescribed by the department, designate one of the nonprofit organization's members as a liaison for communicating with the department regarding number plates, specify the surcharge and whether the surcharge is required on renewal, and submit acceptable proof of the nonprofit status of the organization.
