3 Bismarck; Sgt. Keith L. Smette, Makoti; Spc. Philip D. Brown, Jamestown; Staff Sgt. Lance J.  
4 Koenig, Fargo; Spc. Cody L. Wentz, Williston; Pfc. Anthony W. Monroe, Bismarck; Spc.  
5 Thomas J. Sweet II, Bismarck; and Pfc. Sheldon R. Hawk Eagle, Grand Forks, were called  
6 upon by the United States of America to fight the forces of terror that threaten free men; and
