- 1 A concurrent resolution urging the Federal Aviation Administration to maintain the Grand Forks
- 2 Automated Flight Service Station as a federal air traffic facility properly staffed by government
- 3 employees.

- WHEREAS, the Grand Forks Automated Flight Service Station provides pilots with
- 5 weather and aeronautical data to help them make critical and often lifesaving decisions; and
- 6 WHEREAS, whether assisting University of North Dakota student pilots, coordinating air
- 7 ambulance flights to our rural communities, relaying data to commercial operators flying
- 8 passengers and supplies over the state, often in the worst of weather, or assisting the military in
- 9 matters of national security, the Grand Forks Automated Flight Service Station provides an
- 10 invaluable service that is intimately related to the public interest; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the Grand Forks Automated Flight Service Station is responsible for the
- 12 continuous monitoring of international border air space and daily support of the missions of the
- 13 Minot Air Force Base, Grand Forks Air Force Base, Fargo Air National Guard, and Bismarck
- 14 National Guard flight operations; and
- WHEREAS, maintaining the Grand Forks Automated Flight Service Station with proper
- 16 staffing levels and equipment is a fundamental necessity in the continuation of these crucial
- 17 services; and
- 18 **WHEREAS**, the Federal Aviation Administration is primarily responsible for the safety
- 19 and security of aviation;
- 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
- 21 OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
- 22 That the Fifty-ninth Legislative Assembly urges the Federal Aviation Administration to
- 23 maintain the Grand Forks Automated Flight Service Station as a federal air traffic facility
- 24 properly staffed by government employees; and

- 1 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this
- 2 resolution to the President and Vice President of the United States, the administrator of the
- 3 Federal Aviation Administration, and to each member of the United States Senate and United
- 4 States House of Representatives.
