1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 4-01-17.3 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to the disposition of furs taken by the United States department of agriculture wildlife
3 services.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 4-01-17.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is
6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 **4-01-17.3. Disposition of proceeds of furs, skins, and specimens taken.** All furs,
8 skins, and specimens taken by hunters and trappers paid out of funds appropriated to carry out
9 section 4-01-17.1 must be disposed of in a manner the agriculture commissioner determines is
10 in the state's best interests. If furs, skins, or specimens are sold, the net proceeds of the sales,
11 up to fifteen thousand dollars, must be ~~deposited with the state treasurer to be credited to the~~
12 ~~general fund~~ used by United States department of agriculture wildlife services to fund its
13 program activities that benefit the state's livestock producers.
