1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15.1-22-01 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to the provision of kindergarten programs.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-22-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

15.1-22-01. Kindergarten - Establishment by board - Petition for establishment <u>Request by parent</u> - Levy.

8	1.	Upon its own motion, the board of a school district may establish a free public
9		kindergarten for the instruction during a school year of resident children below
10		school age.
11	2.	If the board receives a petition signed by qualified electors residing in the district
12		equal in number to at least twenty percent of those who voted in the most recent

13 annual school district election, the board must submit the question of establishing a

14 kindergarten to the electorate at the next annual or special school district election.

15 The margins of electoral approval provided in section 57-15-14 must be applied

16 written request to provide kindergarten from the parent of a student who will be

17 <u>enrolled in the kindergarten, the board shall either provide at least a half-day</u>

18 kindergarten program for the student or pay the tuition required for the student to

19 attend at least a half-day kindergarten program in another school district.

3. The board of a school district that establishes a kindergarten under this section
may levy a tax pursuant to subdivision p of subsection 1 of section 57-15-14.2.
