- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 20.1-07-04 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the destruction and disposition of depredating fur-bearing animals.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 20.1-07-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **20.1-07-04.** Depredating fur-bearing animals Destruction and disposition. A
- 7 landowner or tenant or that person's agent may catch or kill any wild fur-bearing animal that is
- 8 committing depredations upon that person's poultry, domestic animals, or crops. A, except a
- 9 landowner or tenant or that person's agent shall notify and obtain the approval of the director
- 10 before catching or killing a black bear. Except as provided in this section, a A landowner or
- 11 tenant or that person's agent may not commercialize in, sell, or ship an animal or the pelt or any
- 12 part of an animal caught or killed under this section if caught or killed during the closed season.
- 13 The landowner or tenant or that person's agent may possess a black bear killed under this
- 14 section. A person catching or killing a black bear or mountain lion under this section shall
- 15 report the capture or killing to the department within twenty-four hours and the entire animal
- 16 must be turned over to the department.
