The primary fiscal impact of HB 1374 is supported in HB 1013 and HB 1154 and federal funds from the Elementary and Secondary Education Act, which provide funding for services for English Language Learners. HB 1013 includes \$650,000 for services for English Language Learners and \$275,000 for standards and assessment for English Language Learners. HB 1154 includes foundation aid for educational needs of all children. It also includes \$300,000 in Contingent monies for English Language Learners, available as carryover funding at the end of the biennium.

There is no additional fiscal impact on the state or local school districts since HB 1374 simply clarifies in North Dakota Century Code responsibilities for English language learners that are presently required by federal legislation. It does not create a new program, but provides assurances that students will receive an appropriate instructional program and the State will assist school districts in implementing the program. It also assures that the State has the capacity to meet the needs of English language learners through state levels activities, including advisory committee, standards, technical assistance, and administration, of which the costs would be supported through appropriation in HB 1013.
