This bill increases the fee for resident wholesale bait licenses from \$30 to \$50. It establishes Class A and Class B nonresident wholesale bait vender licenses. The Class A license allows the nonresident to trap bait in North Dakota. The Class B license allows importation of bait but does not allow trapping of bait in North Dakota. A tagging system for the equipment used by Class A license holders is also established.

It is estimated that seven nonresident Class A wholesale bait vender licenses and four Class B licenses will be issued annually. About thirty resident wholesale bait licenses are issued annually. The revenue increase from the changes in this bill is estimated to be \$2,300 per year.
