- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 34-06 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the state minimum wage.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 34-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is

- 5 created and enacted as follows:
- State minimum wage rate Adjustments.
 1. Except as otherwise provided under this chapter and rules adopted by the
 commissioner, every employer shall pay to each of the employer's employees a
 minimum wage in the amount specified under this section.
- Effective August 1, 2007, the minimum wage rate is seven dollars and twenty-five
 cents per hour. Beginning with calendar year 2009, the North Dakota minimum
 wage must be adjusted annually for inflation, as provided under this section.
- 133.No later than September thirtieth of each year, beginning in calendar year 2008,14the commissioner shall calculate an adjustment of the minimum wage rate amount
- 15 based upon the increase, if any, from August of the preceding year to August of the
- 16 year in which the calculation is made in the United States city average consumer
- 17 price index for all urban consumers for all items as prepared by the bureau of labor
- 18 statistics of the United States department of labor. The commissioner shall round
- 19 the adjusted minimum wage rate to the nearest five cents. The adjusted minimum
- 20 wage rate becomes effective January first immediately following the calculation.
