- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 26.1-36-37.2 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to loss ratios for accident and health insurers.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 26.1-36-37.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **26.1-36-37.2.** Loss ratios Rules. For all policies providing hospital, surgical,
- 7 medical, or major medical benefit, an insurance company, a nonprofit health service
- 8 corporation, a fraternal benefit society, and any other entity providing a plan of health insurance
- 9 or health benefit subject to state insurance regulation shall return benefits to group
- 10 policyholders in the aggregate of not less than seventy-five sixty-five percent of premium
- 11 received and to individual policyholders in the aggregate of not less than sixty five fifty-five
- 12 percent of premium received, as determined by the commissioner. The commissioner shall
- 13 adopt rules to establish these minimum standards on the basis of incurred claims experienced
- 14 and earned premiums for the entire period for which rates are computed to provide coverage in
- 15 accordance with accepted actuarial principles and practices. This section does not apply to
- 16 any contract or plan of insurance that provides exclusively for accident, disability income
- 17 insurance, specified disease, hospital confinement indemnity, or other limited benefit health
- 18 insurance.
