- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 20.1-03-35 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to use of identification numbers on game and fish licenses and permits.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 20.1-03-35 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 20.1-03-35. Social security number to be furnished. The social security number of an applicant for any license or permit issued under this chapter must be recorded on the
- 8 application unless the applicant is a foreign national to whom no social security number has
- 9 been issued. A social security number recorded under this section is confidential. <u>Beginning</u>
- 10 on January 1, 2008, any application that is printed in paper form must be printed in a manner
- 11 so that the applicant's social security number is recorded only on the original application.
- 12 Unless otherwise required by federal law, the original paper application must be returned to the
- 13 applicant after the application is completed and a duplicate application has been retained by
- 14 the person accepting the application.
