- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 38-08-05 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to oil and gas well location restrictions.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 38-08-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **38-08-05. Drilling permit required.** It is unlawful to commence operations for the
- 7 drilling of a well for oil or gas without first obtaining a permit from the industrial commission
- 8 under such rules as may be prescribed by the commission and paying to the commission a fee
- 9 for each such well in an amount to be prescribed by the commission. At least twenty days
- 10 before applying for a permit, the applicant shall give notice of intention to apply for a permit to
- 11 the record owner, as set forth in the office of the county treasurer. The applicant also shall
- 12 notify the owner of any permanently occupied dwelling located within one-quarter mile [402.34
- 13 meters] of the proposed oil or gas well. If the occupied dwelling lies within city limits,
- 14 notification may be given by contacting the local governing board. Unless waived by the
- 15 occupant, the commission may not issue a drilling permit for an oil or gas well that will be
- 16 located within five hundred feet [152.4 meters] of an occupied dwelling.
