- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 47-05 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to severance of hunting rights from the surface estate.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 47-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 **Severance of hunting rights prohibited.** The right to shoot, shoot at, pursue, take,
- 7 <u>attempt to take, or kill any game animals or game birds; search for or attempt to locate or flush</u>
- 8 any game animals and game birds; lure, call, or attempt to attract game animals or game birds;
- 9 hide for the purpose of taking or attempting to take game animals or game birds; and walk,
- 10 <u>crawl, or advance toward wildlife while possessing implements or equipment useful in the</u>
- 11 taking of game animals or game birds may not be severed from the surface estate. This
- 12 section does not apply to deeds, instruments, or interests in property recorded before the
- 13 effective date of this Act and does not apply to the private lands habitat and access
- 14 improvement program under title 20.1.
