- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 15.1-21-01 and 15.1-21-02 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to required instruction and North Dakota studies.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-21-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
