FIRST ENGROSSMENT with Senate Amendments

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1429

- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide a transfer and appropriation from the general fund; to amend and
- 2 reenact section 54-27.2-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the budget
- 3 stabilization fund; and to provide an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. TRANSFER APPROPRIATION.** Notwithstanding the provisions of
- 6 sections 54-27.2-01 and 54-27.2-02, there is appropriated out of any moneys in the general
- 7 fund the sum of \$100,527,369 which the state treasurer shall transfer to the budget stabilization
- 8 fund on July 1, 2007, based on the end-of-biennium balance in the general fund on June 30,
- 9 2007. This transfer will provide for a total of \$200,000,000 in the budget stabilization fund for
- 10 the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009.
- 11 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-27.2-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 12 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 13 **54-27.2-01. Budget stabilization fund.** The budget stabilization fund is a special fund
- 14 in the state treasury. The state investment board shall supervise investment of the budget
- 15 stabilization fund in accordance with chapter 21-10. Any interest or other budget stabilization
- 16 fund earnings must be deposited in the fund. Any amounts provided by law for deposit in the
- 17 fund and any interest or earnings of the fund which would bring the balance in the fund to an
- 18 amount greater than five ten percent of the current biennial state general fund budget, as finally
- 19 approved by the most recently adjourned special or regular session of the legislative assembly,
- 20 may not be deposited or retained in the fund but must be deposited instead in the state general
- 21 fund.
- 22 **SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** Section 2 of this Act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
