1 A BILL for an Act to provide for limitations on for-profit activities of nonprofit organizations.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. Nonprofit organizations Limitation on activities.

 1. As used in this section, nonprofit organization means an organization or trust that
 has tax-exempt status under at least one of the following sections of the Internal
 Revenue Code:

 a. An organization that is organized and operated exclusively for religious,
 charitable, scientific, testing for public safety, literary, or educational purposes,
 or for the prevention of cruelty to children or animals under section 501(c)(3),
 - <u>b.</u> A charitable, religious, educational, or scientific organization classified as either a private foundation or as a public charity having status as an organization described in section 509(a)(1) or (3).

or is a domestic fraternal organization under section 501(c)(10).

- <u>A trust described in section 4947 for which a deduction is allowable under</u> section 170.
- 2. A nonprofit organization that directly or indirectly receives federal, state, or local tax revenues may not have an ownership interest in a for-profit organization that competes with any other for-profit organization.
