| 7 | | cord blood to a public cord blood bank may not be charged for the costs of |
| 8 | | collecting, storing, or transporting the cord blood. |
| 9 | <u>2.</u> | A hospital is not required to collect cord blood if in the professional judgment of a |
| 10 | | licensed physician the collection of the cord blood would threaten the health of the |
| 11 | | mother or newborn child. This section does not require a hospital or hospital |
| 12 | | employee, including a physician, nurse, or other medical staff, to collect cord blood |
| 13 | | if the collection of cord blood conflicts with the bona fide religious practices and |
| 14 | | beliefs of the hospital or hospital employee. This section does not require a |
| 15 | | hospital to arrange for the donation of blood extracted from umbilical cords. |
