1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 20.1-04-15 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to the age requirement for the youth pheasant hunting season.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 20.1-04-15 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

6 20.1-04-15. (Effective through July 31, 2007) Pheasant season - Opening. The 7 open or lawful season on pheasant and the open or lawful season on duck may not commence 8 on the same weekend. Except as otherwise provided in this section for the opening of 9 pheasant season for youth, the open or lawful season on pheasant may not open earlier than 10 one-half hour before sunrise and the season may not commence earlier than the first Saturday 11 of October of any given year. The governor, in the governor's proclamation, may provide a 12 pheasant hunting season for youth ages twelve through sixteen and under on the Saturday and 13 Sunday preceding the opening of the regular pheasant season. If a youth's seventeenth 14 birthday occurs during the special hunting season, that person may hunt for the duration of the 15 special youth season. 16 (Effective after July 31, 2007) Pheasant season - Opening. The open or lawful 17 season on pheasant and the open or lawful season on duck may not commence on the same 18 weekend. The open or lawful season on pheasant may not open earlier than one half hour 19 before sunrise and the season may not commence earlier than the first Saturday of October of

20 any given year.
