## ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1311

- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 20.1-03-01.2, 20.1-03-01.3, and 20.1-04-15 of
- 2 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to hunter safety education requirements and the age
- 3 requirement for the youth pheasant hunting season.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 20.1-03-01.2 of the North Dakota Century Code 6 is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 20.1-03-01.2. Instruction required before issuance of hunting license Age limits
- 8 Penalty. No person An individual born after December 31, 1961, except as provided in
- 9 section 20.1-03-01.3, may not be issued any a hunting license in this state unless that person
- 10 individual submits or exhibits the certificate of completion earned by that person individual for
- 11 successful completion of the hunter safety education course of instruction required by sections
- 12 20.1-03-01.1 through 20.1-03-01.3 or the person individual submits or exhibits a prior North
- 13 Dakota hunting license issued to that person individual with that person's individual's hunter
- 14 education certificate number on the license. A certificate of completion issued by any other
- another state or province of Canada is valid for all purposes. Any person An individual who
- 16 purchases a hunting license without successfully completing the a hunter safety education
- 17 course of instruction required by sections 20.1-03-01.1 through 20.1-03-01.3 is guilty of a
- 18 class 2 noncriminal offense.
- 19 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 20.1-03-01.3 of the North Dakota Century Code
- 20 is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 21 **20.1-03-01.3. Exemptions Exemption**. Sections 20.1-03-01.1 through 20.1-03-01.3
- 22 do not apply to:
- 23 1. Persons under twelve years of age who hunt only with their parent or legal
- 24 guardian.

2. Persons individuals who hunt exclusively on land of which they are the record title
owner or operator.

**SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Section 20.1-04-15 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

20.1-04-15. (Effective through July 31, 2007) Pheasant season - Opening. The open or lawful season on pheasant and the open or lawful season on duck may not commence on the same weekend. Except as otherwise provided in this section for the opening of pheasant season for youth, the open or lawful season on pheasant may not open earlier than one-half hour before sunrise and the season may not commence earlier than the first Saturday of October of any given year. The governor, in the governor's proclamation, may provide a pheasant hunting season for youth ages twelve through sixteen and under, who have completed a certified state or provincial hunter safety education course, on the Saturday and Sunday preceding the opening of the regular pheasant season. If a youth's seventeenth birthday occurs during the special hunting season, that person may hunt for the duration of the special youth season.

(Effective after July 31, 2007) Pheasant season - Opening. The open or lawful season on pheasant and the open or lawful season on duck may not commence on the same weekend. The open or lawful season on pheasant may not open earlier than one-half hour before sunrise and the season may not commence earlier than the first Saturday of October of any given year.
