3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY - PROTECTION OF CONSUMER 4 TELEPHONE RECORDS STUDY. During the 2007-08 interim, the legislative council shall 5 6 consider studying issues relating to the protection of consumer telephone records. The study 7 must include a review of federal legislation on the protection of telephone records and the 8 possible state responses considering federal legislation so that the needs of the citizens of 9 North Dakota as to privacy of telephone records are met. The legislative council shall report its 10 findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the 11 recommendations, to the sixty-first legislative assembly.
