- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 57-39.2 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to allocation of city sales tax collections to the home school district of a
- 3 purchaser if the city allocates home rule sales tax revenues to a school district within the city.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 57-39.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 created and enacted as follows:
- 7 City sales tax allocation to home school district. Each retailer located within the city
- 8 limits of a city imposing a sales tax under home rule authority from which revenue is transferred
- 9 to a school district in that city shall provide the purchaser in each retail sale subject to the city
- 10 home rule sales tax a designation form with the sales receipt for the taxable sale if the
- 11 purchaser is not a resident of that city. The city auditor shall provide the designation form to
- 12 retailers. Each retailer shall file completed forms provided by purchasers with the tax
- 13 commissioner with the retailer's sales tax return for the taxable period. The designation form
- 14 may be used by a purchaser to designate the home school district of the purchaser's residence
- 15 within North Dakota for receipt of the city sales tax collected on the sale. The tax commissioner
- 16 shall allocate from sales tax collections within each city the amounts designated by purchasers
- 17 under this section for allocation to school districts and transmit those funds to those school
- 18 districts before transferring city sales tax collections to the cities in which the purchases were
- 19 made. The tax commissioner may not make an allocation to a school district unless it is in the
- amount of five dollars or more.
