- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15.1-07-20 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to requirements for drivers of school vehicles.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-07-20 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 15.1-07-20. Schoolbus School vehicle driver Requirements.
  - To Except as provided in subsection 2, to be eligible to drive a schoolbus or other school vehicle for which a commercial driver's license is not required, an individual must:
    - a. Hold a <del>valid</del> North Dakota driver's license:
- b. Be free from communicable diseases:
- 12 c. Be in good physical health and have normal use of both hands, both feet, 13 both eyes, and both ears;
- d. Be of sound mental health;
  - e. Pass any drug and alcohol screening tests required by the school board; and
  - f. Be at least twenty-one years of age, unless the board of a school district determines that an individual not meeting this requirement can safely and adequately perform the required duties.
  - 2. To be eligible to drive a school vehicle that is designed to seat ten to fifteen people, an individual must:
  - a. Hold a North Dakota driver's license;
- b. Meet the physical and medical requirements established for commercial
   vehicle drivers; and

c. Complete any annual training required by the superintendent of public instruction.
 3. Each year, the board of a school district shall designate licensed health care

schoolbus and school vehicle drivers.

Prior to commencing duties as the driver of a schoolbus or other school vehicle,
whether employed by the school district or by another entity with whom the school
board has contracted, and every two years thereafter, an individual shall present to
the school board verification by a designated health care professional that the
individual has been examined and meets the health, physical, and medical
requirements of this section.

This section does not prohibit apply to teachers or administrators who are employed by the district from and who are operating vehicles other than schoolbuses for the purpose of transporting students to regular or special events related to educational programs in which the students are enrolled.
