- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to property damage payments from the unsatisfied judgment

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## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 26.1-23-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 amended and reenacted as follows:

## 26.1-23-04. Recovery from fund. When any

8 If a person, who is a resident of this state, recovers in any court in this state a 1. 9 judgment for an amount exceeding three hundred dollars in an action for damages 10 resulting from bodily injury to, or the death of, any person or property damage to a 11 motor vehicle occasioned by, or arising out of, the ownership, maintenance, 12 operation, or use of a motor vehicle by the judgment debtor in this state, upon the 13 judgment becoming final, the judgment creditor may, in accordance with this 14 chapter, apply to the judge of the district court in which the judgment was 15 rendered, upon notice to the attorney general, for an order directing payment of the 16 judgment out of the fund. 17 2. Upon the hearing of the application, the judgment creditor shall show: 18 <del>1.</del> That the creditor has obtained judgment as set out in this section, stating the a. 19 amount thereof of the judgment and the amount owing thereon on the 20 judgment at the time of the application; 21 <del>2.</del> That the creditor has caused an execution to be issued thereon on the b. 22 judgment, and that:

2				property of the judgment debtor liable to be seized in satisfaction of the

5				under the execution, was insufficient to satisfy the judgment, stating the
6				amount so realized and the balance remaining due thereon on the judgment;
7		<del>3.</del>	<u>C.</u>	That the creditor has caused the judgment debtor, when the debtor is
8				available, to be examined pursuant to law for that purpose, touching the
9				debtor's property, and in particular as to whether the debtor is insured under a
10				policy of automobile insurance against loss occasioned by the debtor's legal
11				liability for bodily injury to, or the death of, another person or property damage
12				to a motor vehicle if the creditor is seeking recovery for property damage to a
13				motor vehicle;
14		<del>4.</del>	<u>d.</u>	That the creditor has made an exhaustive search and inquiry to ascertain
15				whether the judgment debtor is possessed of property, real or personal, liable
16				to be sold or applied in satisfaction of the judgment; and
17		<del>5.</del>	<u>e.</u>	That as a result of the search, inquiry, and examination, the creditor has not
18				learned of no any property possessed by the judgment debtor and liable to be
19				sold or applied in satisfaction of the judgment debt, or that the creditor has
20				learned of certain property, describing it, owned by the judgment debtor and
21				liable to be seized or applied in satisfaction of the judgment, and has taken all
22				necessary proceedings for the realization thereof of the property, and that the
23				amount thereby realized was insufficient to satisfy the judgment, stating the
24				amount so realized and the amount remaining due thereon on the judgment.

27		26.1	-23-0	<ol><li>Limitation on amount payable from fund - Nonassignable.</li></ol>
28		1.	Rec	overy from the fund is limited to payment of the following, exclusive of costs:
29			a.	Ten thousand dollars for bodily injury <del>, including</del> to or death, of one person
30				and five thousand dollars for property damage to a motor vehicle in any one
31				accident claim.

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1		b. Twenty thousand dollars for bodily injury, including to or death, of two or more
2		persons in any one accident.
3	2.	The amount authorized to be paid must be within the limits provided by this
4		section, and must be determined as follows:
5		a. If the judgment creditor has effected collection of a portion of the judgment
6		from any source, except as provided for in subdivisions b and c, the fund is
7		authorized to pay the creditor the difference between the amount collected
8		and the amount of the judgment, or ten thousand dollars, whichever is
9		smaller. If the judgment creditor has collected an amount equal to the limits
10		payable from the fund from the insurance or nonexempt assets of the
11		judgment debtor, then the creditor is precluded from recovery from the fund.
12		b. If the judgment creditor has effected collection of a portion of the judgment
13		from payment from workforce safety and insurance, then the amount
14		collected from that source must be subtracted from the judgment before the
15		procedure outlined in subdivision a is followed.
16		c. If the judgment creditor was covered by an uninsured motorist insurance
17		policy at the time of the accident, then the maximum liability limit of that policy
18		must first be subtracted from the judgment before the procedure outlined in
19		subdivision a is followed. If the maximum liability limit of the policy is equal to
20		the limits payable from the fund, then no recovery from the fund is allowed.
21	3.	The right of any person to recover from the unsatisfied judgment fund is not
22		assignable and subrogation of the right is not allowed.
