- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-06.2-06 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to commercial driver's license exemptions.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-06.2-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 amended and reenacted as follows:

## 6 **39-06.2-06. Commercial driver's license required.**

- Except when driving under a commercial driver's instruction permit and
   accompanied by the holder of a commercial driver's license valid for the vehicle
   being driven, no person may drive a commercial motor vehicle on the highways of
   this state unless the person holds and is in immediate possession of a commercial
   driver's license with applicable endorsements valid for the vehicle the person is
   driving. This subsection does not apply:
- a. When the vehicle being driven is a house car or a vehicle towing a travel
  trailer being used solely for personal rather than commercial purposes.
- b. When the vehicle being driven constitutes emergency or firefighting
  equipment necessary to the preservation of life or property.
- No person may drive a commercial motor vehicle on the highways of this state
   while the person's driving privilege is suspended, revoked, or canceled, while
   subject to a disqualification.
- 3. The provisions of this chapter are waived, as to farm-to-market operations by
  farmers, but limited to those operators of a farm vehicle that is:
- 22 a. Controlled and operated by a farmer.
- b. Used to transport either agricultural products, <u>including trees</u>, farm machines,
  farm supplies, or both, to or from a farm.

1		c. Not used in the operations of a common or contract carrier.
2		d. Used within one hundred fifty miles [241.40 kilometers] of the person's farm.
3	4.	The provisions of this chapter are waived as to an individual operating a vehicle at
4		the request of and within a political subdivision during an emergency declared by
5		that political subdivision for the removal of snow and ice.
6	5.	Pursuant to 49 CFR, part 383.3, the required knowledge and skills tests may be
7		waived and a restricted commercial driver's license issued to employees of
8		agrichemical businesses, custom harvesters, farm retail outlets and suppliers,
9		including retailers and suppliers of trees, and livestock feeders.
