- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 39-29 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to equipment of registered off-highway vehicles; and to amend and
- 3 reenact subsection 1 of section 39-29-09 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the
- 4 operation of off-highway vehicles.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 39-29 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
 - Equipment. To be registered, an off-highway vehicle must meet the equipment requirements as determined by the director in conformity with chapter 39-27 as modified to apply to an off-highway vehicle.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 39-29-09 of the North Dakota
 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 1. An individual may not operate an off-highway vehicle on the roadway, shoulder, or inside bank or slope of any road, street, or highway except as provided in this chapter. Except in emergencies, an individual may not operate an off-highway vehicle within the right of way of any controlled-access highway. An individual may operate a registered off-highway vehicle on a gravel, dirt, or loose surface roadway. An individual may operate a registered off-highway vehicle on a paved county or township roadway if the off-highway vehicle is towing an implement of husbandry and does not exceed the speed of twenty five miles [40.23 kilometers] per hour. An individual may operate a registered off-highway vehicle on a paved county or township roadway highway designated and posted at a speed not exceeding forty-five sixty-five miles [72.42 104.61 kilometers] per hour.
