- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 51-25 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the nicotine yield of cigarettes sold in the state.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 51-25 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 <u>Nicotine content of cigarettes sold in the state.</u> <u>Notwithstanding any other provision</u>
- 7 of law, the maximum cigarette nicotine yield calculated using the federal trade commission
- 8 <u>method which a cigarette sold by a tobacco product manufacturer to consumers within this</u>
- 9 state, whether directly or through a distributor, retailer, or similar intermediary, may have is as
- 10 <u>follows:</u>
- 11 <u>1.</u> By August 1, 2008, the cigarette nicotine yield may not exceed one milligram per 12 <u>cigarette;</u>
- 13 <u>2. By August 1, 2009, the cigarette nicotine yield may not exceed eight-tenths of a</u>
 14 <u>milligram per cigarette;</u>
- 15 <u>3.</u> By August 1, 2011, the cigarette nicotine yield may not exceed five-tenths of a
 milligram per cigarette;
- 4. By August 1, 2013, the cigarette nicotine yield may not exceed two-tenths of a
 milligram per cigarette; and
- 5. By August 1, 2015, the cigarette nicotine yield must be less than one
 one-hundredth of a milligram per cigarette.
