1 A BILL for an Act to require the public service commission to study grain inspection procedures
2 and report to the legislative council.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION STUDY OF GRAIN INSPECTION**

5 **PROCEDURES - REPORT TO THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.** During the 2007-08 interim, the
6 public service commission shall conduct a study of grain inspection procedures in this state.
7 The study must address the methodology, accuracy, uniformity, and cost-effectiveness of
8 testing and sampling procedures and must determine training and education standards that
9 would be desirable in improving current procedures. The public service commission shall work
10 with agencies of the United States department of agriculture, industry groups, and North Dakota
11 state university in conducting the study. The public service commission shall present a report
12 regarding its findings and recommendations as a result of the study to the legislative council
13 before September 1, 2008.
