4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

AND VOLUNTEER TRAINING - REPORT TO LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL. During the 2007-08 interim, the state department of health shall conduct a survey of the system in the state through which employees and volunteers, who are not trained as physicians or nurses, are providing public health and safety services. The survey must include the collection of data on the types and numbers of employees and volunteers providing these services, the types of services being provided, and the forum in which these services are being provided. The department shall use this survey data to make recommendations regarding the feasibility of providing standardized training and distance training to these employees and volunteers providing these public health and safety services. Before July 1, 2008, the state health officer shall provide a report to the legislative council on the outcome and recommendations of the survey, including any proposed legislative measures the department may propose to the sixty-first legislative assembly to further these recommendations.
