HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3063

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the delivery and funding of
2 veterans' services by the state and counties.

3 **WHEREAS**, so long as the people of this state live free there will be veterans of military
4 service who have sacrificed to secure that freedom; and

5 **WHEREAS**, these veterans are entitled to a host of state and federal benefits and may
6 seek advice and aid from the United States Department of Veterans' Affairs, North Dakota
7 Department of Veterans' Affairs, or a county veterans' service officer in obtaining these benefits;
8 and

9 **WHEREAS**, the various state and federal veterans' benefits programs are constantly
10 changing; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the state and the counties do not have adequate human or financial
12 resources to provide the maximum service necessary to ensure that eligible veterans receive
13 the benefits to which they are entitled; and

14 **WHEREAS**, providing the qualifying benefits to all eligible veterans meets the goal for
15 which these benefits were created - repaying veterans for their dedicated service;

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**
17 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

18 That the Legislative Council study the delivery of veterans' services by the state and
19 counties; and

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
21 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
22 the Sixty-first Legislative Assembly.
