1 A concurrent resolution urging the Secretary of the Navy to name a ship the USS North Dakota.

2 WHEREAS, the state of North Dakota has had only one ship named after this state, the

3 USS North Dakota, which was decommissioned in November 1923; and

4 WHEREAS, 24 states have ships currently named after the state and 21 states have

5 had two or more ships named after the state, leaving only five states that have had only one

6 ship named after the state, including North Dakota; and

WHEREAS, the state of North Dakota has shown unwavering support for members of
the armed forces and strongly supports memorializing their service with the naming of a Navy
ship the USS North Dakota;

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE

11 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

12 That the Sixtieth Legislative Assembly urges the Secretary of the Navy to name a ship13 the USS North Dakota; and

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this

15 resolution to the Secretary of the Navy and each member of the North Dakota Congressional

16 Delegation.
