1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 48-10-02 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to use of and expenditures from the capitol building fund.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 48-10-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **48-10-02. Capitol building fund to be administered by the capitol grounds**
7 **planning commission - Continuing appropriation - Procedure for expenditure of certain**
8 **funds.** The capitol grounds planning commission shall have general powers to superintend the
9 administration of the capitol building fund, its interest and income fund, and its investments and
10 properties. It may cause any lands now held in such funds to be sold at market value, direct the
11 conversion of any securities now held by such funds to cash, approve expenditures from such
12 funds subject to law and legislative appropriations, and to do all other things necessary to carry
13 out the intent and purposes of this section. The board of university and school lands or its
14 designee, on the commission's behalf, shall see to the investment and management of the
15 capitol building fund and its interest and income fund and shall account to the commission
16 concerning these funds at the commission's request.

17 ~~Provided further, all moneys and other property in the capitol building fund, except as~~
18 ~~otherwise appropriated, are hereby dedicated and reserved to the exclusive purpose of the~~
19 ~~construction of an addition to the legislative wing of the state capitol building, and the capitol~~
20 ~~grounds planning commission shall take necessary steps to accumulate and conserve the~~
21 ~~money and property in the capitol building fund for such purpose.~~

22 The commission may, during any biennium, expend from the interest and income fund
23 of the capitol building fund a sum not to exceed fifty percent of the unencumbered balance on
24 the first day of any biennium, and such amount is hereby appropriated to the capitol grounds

- 1 planning commission. The expenditure may be made, after consideration of the capitol grounds
- 2 master plan, for projects or planning but shall not exceed ~~fifty~~ one hundred thousand dollars per
- 3 biennium. The expenditure may only be made upon approval by two-thirds of the total
- 4 membership of the commission. The expenditure must be made upon a voucher, or vouchers,
- 5 prepared by the office of management and budget at the direction of the commission.
