ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1134

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 44-04-18.14 and subsection 3 of section
2 52-01-03 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to release and use of information provided
3 to the followup information on North Dakota education and training system.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 44-04-18.14 of the North Dakota Century Code is
6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 **44-04-18.14. ~~Certain records of occupational information coordinating committee~~**
8 **~~–Exempt~~ Information provided to the followup information on North Dakota education**
9 **and training system.** ~~Records provided to~~

- 10 1. Except as provided in this section, the ~~North Dakota occupational information~~
11 ~~coordinating committee by any person for use in the followup information on North~~
12 ~~Dakota education and training system may not release information provided to it~~
13 ~~for research or statistical purposes may only be used by a participating agency in~~
14 ~~any manner that identifies an individual.~~
- 15 2. The followup information on North Dakota education and training system may use
16 personally identifiable information to ~~prepare produce~~ aggregate data compilations
17 ~~that do not identify any individual and may not be disclosed to the public by the~~
18 ~~occupational information coordinating committee. A request for disclosure of the~~
19 ~~records under section 44-04-18 or section 6 of article XI of the Constitution of~~
20 ~~North Dakota must be directed to the person or entity that has provided the~~
21 ~~records to the occupational information coordinating committee~~ statistics that may
22 ~~be provided to a participating agency.~~

1 3. Unless prohibited by state or federal law, the followup information on North Dakota
2 education and training system may provide personally identifiable information to a
3 participating agency, but may not provide that information to any other person.

4 4. Unless prohibited by state or federal law, a participating agency may use
5 personally identifiable information to fulfill its obligations for state and federal
6 statistical reporting. Personally identifiable information provided by a participating
7 agency to the followup information on North Dakota education and training system
8 which the followup information on North Dakota education and training system
9 releases to another participating agency may not be used or released for any other
10 purpose by that other participating agency without the consent of the identified
11 individual or as otherwise authorized by law.

12 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 3 of section 52-01-03 of the North Dakota
13 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

14 3. Job service North Dakota may provide workforce safety and insurance, the labor
15 commissioner, the driver's license division of the department of transportation, the
16 department of human services, the department of commerce, the state tax
17 commissioner, and the ~~North Dakota occupational information coordinating~~
18 ~~committee~~ followup information on North Dakota education and training system
19 with information obtained pursuant to the administration of the unemployment
20 insurance program, and may enter into interagency agreements with those entities
21 for the exchange of information that will enhance the administration of the
22 unemployment insurance program. Any information furnished pursuant to this
23 subsection or pursuant to interagency agreements authorized by this subsection is
24 to be used for governmental purposes only.
