- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 16.1-10-04 and 16.1-10-06.2 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to corrupt election practices.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 16.1-10-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 16.1-10-04. Publication of false information in political advertisements Penalty.
- 7 No A person may <u>not</u> knowingly sponsor any political advertisement or news release that
- 8 contains any assertion, representation, or statement of fact, including information concerning a
- 9 candidate's prior public record, which the sponsor knows to be untrue, deceptive, or misleading,
- whether on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office, initiated measure,
- 11 referred measure, constitutional amendment, or any other issue, question, or proposal on an
- 12 election ballot, and whether such publication is by radio, television, newspaper, pamphlet,
- 13 folder, display cards, signs, posters, et billboard advertisements, web sites, or by any other
- 14 public means. Any person who violates the provisions of this section is guilty of a class A
- 15 misdemeanor.
- **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 16.1-10-06.2 of the North Dakota Century Code
- 17 is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 18 **16.1-10-06.2. Sale or distribution at polling place.** No A person may not approach a
- 19 person attempting to enter a polling place, or who is in a polling place, for the purpose of
- 20 selling, soliciting for sale, advertising for sale, or distributing any merchandise, product,
- 21 literature, or service. This prohibition applies A person may not approach a person attempting
- 22 to enter a polling place, who is in a polling place, or who is leaving a polling place for the
- 23 purpose of gathering signatures for an initiated measure. These prohibitions apply in any

- 1 polling place or within one hundred feet [30.48 meters] from any entrance leading into a polling
- 2 place on election day.
