5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 11 of section 53-06.2-01 of the North Dakota
 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 11. "Racing" means live or simulcast horse racing under the certificate system or simulcast dog racing under the certificate system, including the transmission of historic previously run horse races.
- SECTION 2. Subsection 7 to section 53-06.2-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 7. a. For each transmission of historic previously run horse races in this state on
 win, place, show, and exotic parimutuel pools, the licensee shall deduct up to
 seventeen percent of the total win, place, show, and exotic pool. Of this
 amount deducted:
 - (1) Five percent must be paid to the commission for deposit in the purse fund:
- 19 (2) Five percent must be paid to the commission for deposit in the breeders' fund; and
- 21 (3) Five percent must be paid to the commission for deposit in the racing promotion fund.
