## ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1383

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15.1-09-08 and subsection 1 of section  
2 15.1-09-13 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to precincts for school board elections.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-09-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **15.1-09-08. School district elections - Candidate filings.** An individual seeking  
7 election to the board of a school district shall prepare and sign a document stating the  
8 individual's name and the position for which that individual is a candidate. A candidate shall  
9 also file a statement of interests as required by section 16.1-09-02. If the election is held in  
10 conjunction with a statewide election, these documents must be filed with the school district  
11 business manager, or mailed to and in the possession of the business manager, by four p.m. of  
12 the sixtieth day before the election. If the election is not held in conjunction with a statewide  
13 election, the document must be filed with the school district business manager, or mailed to and  
14 in the possession of the business manager, by four p.m. of the ~~thirty-third~~ sixtieth day before  
15 the election.

16 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 15.1-09-13 of the North Dakota  
17 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

18 1. At least thirty-five days prior to the annual election, the board of each school  
19 district shall designate one or more precincts for the election. The board shall  
20 arrange the precincts in a way that divides the electors of the district as equally as  
21 possible. ~~No precinct may have a population in excess of six thousand residents,~~  
22 ~~as shown by the last federal decennial census.~~
